


FRANCIS LINE (FATHER HALL), APPENDIX TO THE PYRAMIDICAL DIAL

“AN APPENDIX TO CLAVIS HOROLOGIE OR AN EXPLICATION OF THE PYRAMIDICAL DYAL Set up In His Majesties Garden at *White Hall*, Anno 1669.” was first printed in Liège in 1673 then in London in 1685. This is identical to the Appendix in John Holwell’s Book, ‘Arithmetical Dialling’ already featured. Its contents are:

Of the Four Glass-Bowls supported by the Four Branches of the Great Globe.

CHAP XI.

Of the Three uppermost Pieces of the Pyramid.
