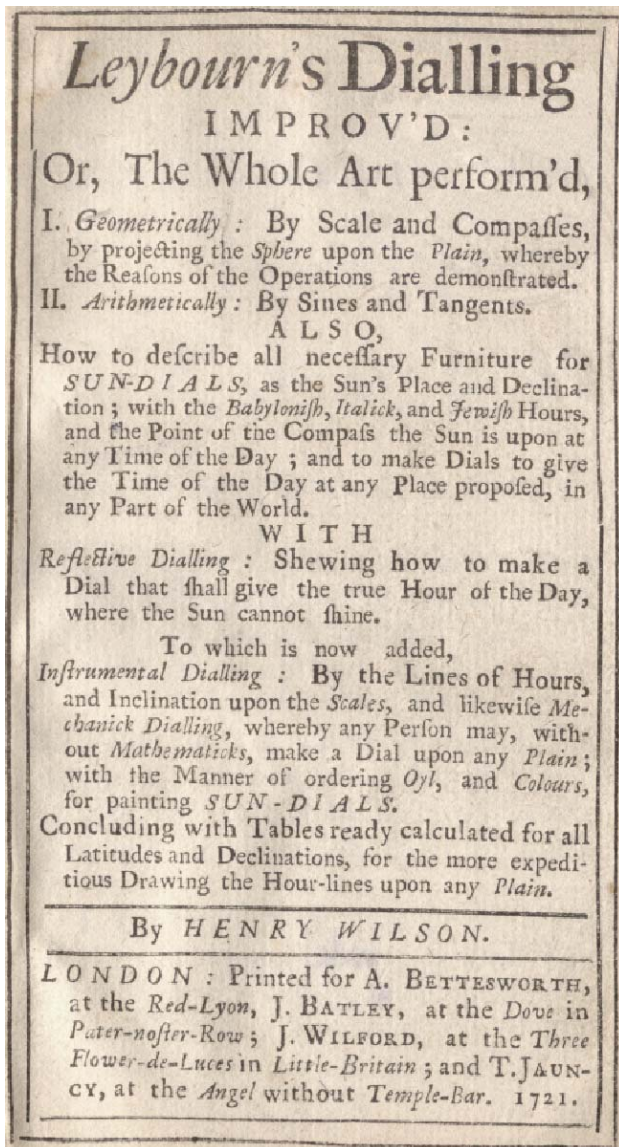


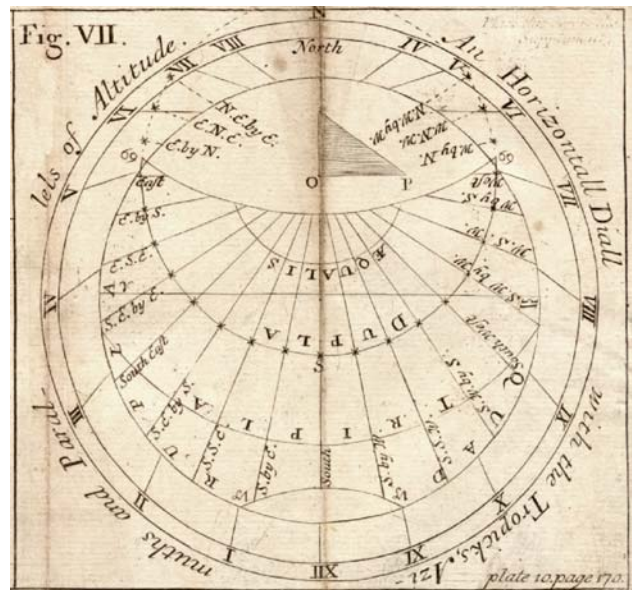
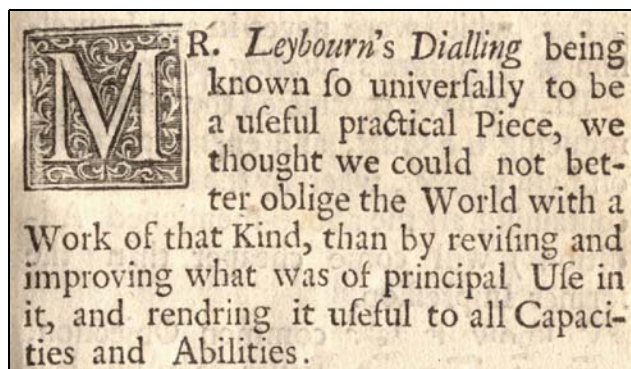
HENRY WILSON, LEYBOURN'S DIALLING IMPROV'D
