The Book's Attractive Front Cover



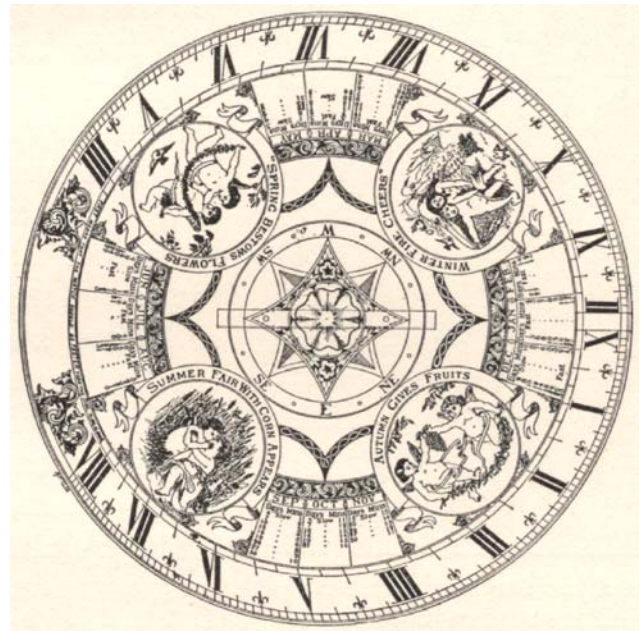
Tower of the Winds, Athens
