


This book appears to be the forerunner of his better known work **Ye SUNDIAL BOOKE** published in 1914. It contains 101 of the sketches by Dorothy Hartley, each with a verse of Henslow's below it. All of these images are repeated in his later book with the exception of one; that is the Horizontal Dial plate illustrated opposite.

The book cover is printed in gold on a white card with an interesting creature at the centre with the inscription "ESSE QUAM VIDERI". The cover also has four bands, presumably for holding a ribbon.

It is not known if PART II was ever published.
