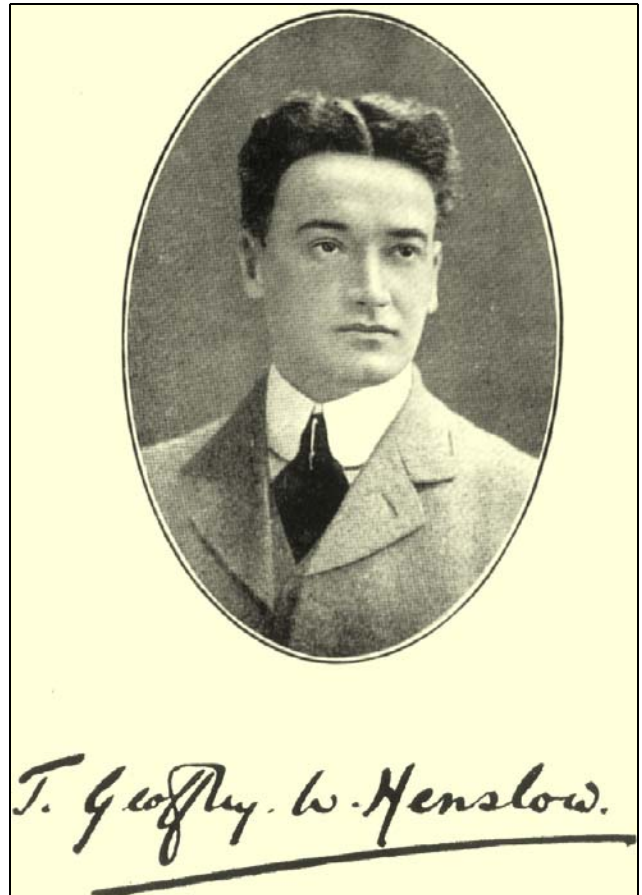
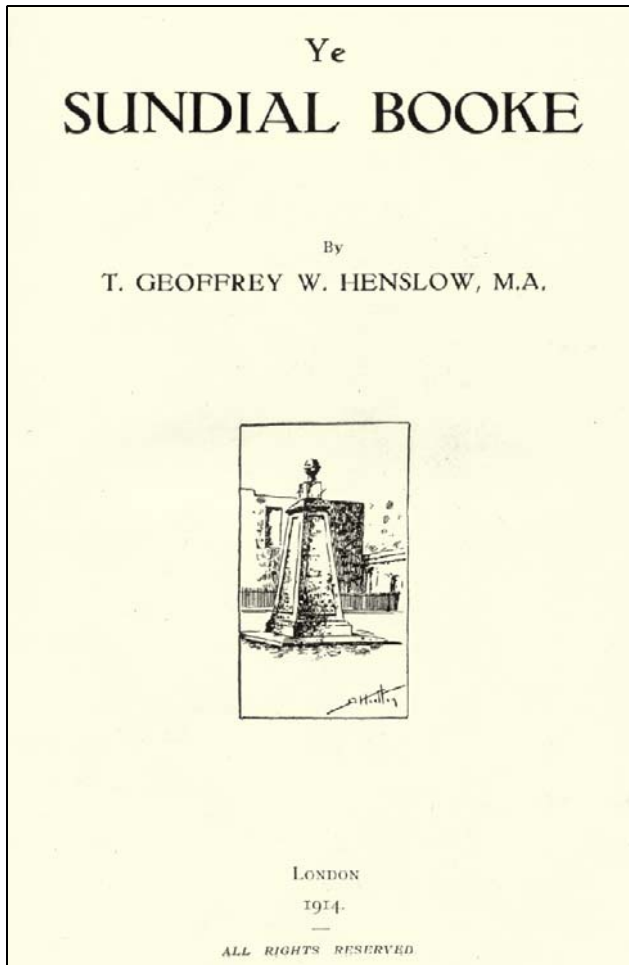


T. GEOFFREY W. HENSLOW, YE SUNDIAL BOOKE

Famous Men and the Sundial with Notes on Mottoes.

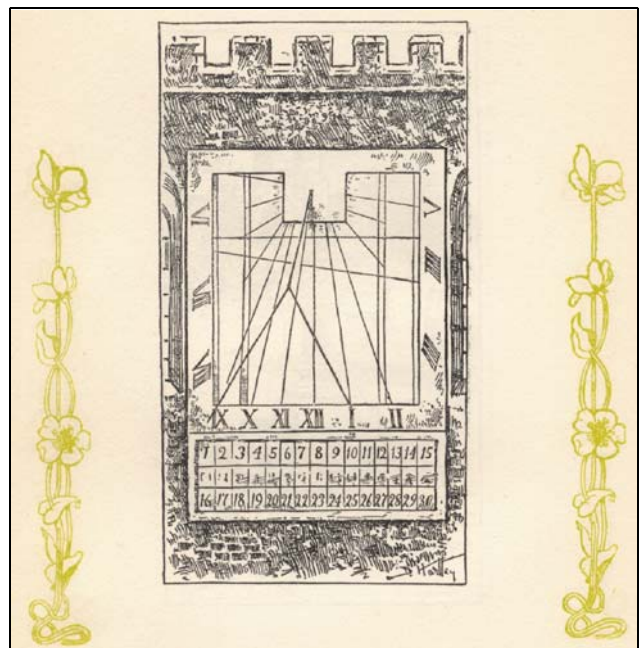

Drawing of the Dial at Queens' College Cambridge, the page complete with its two flower borders

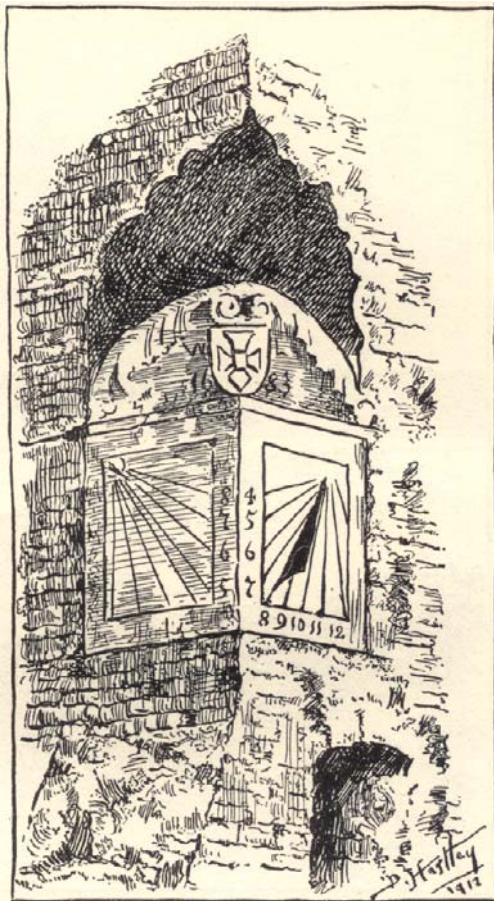

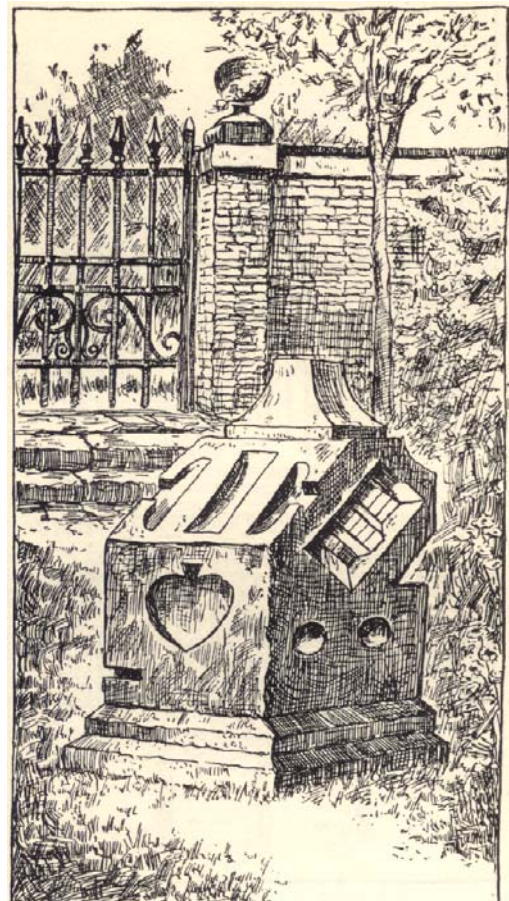

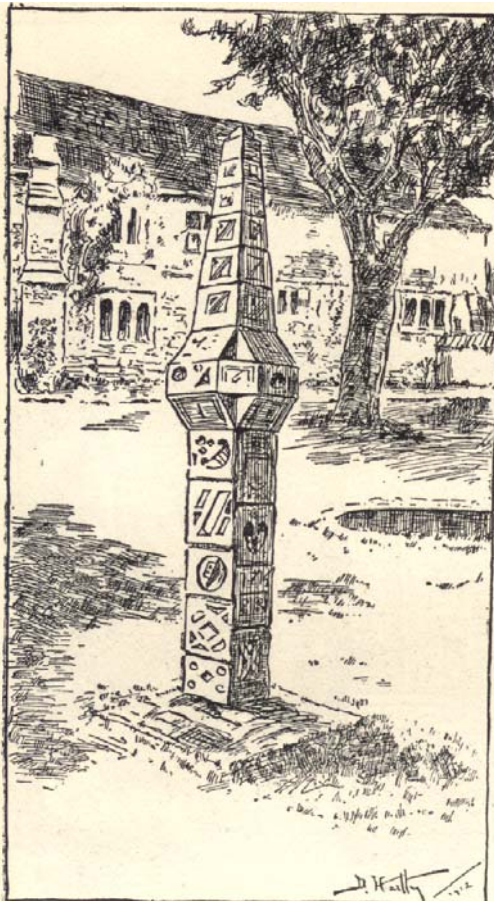

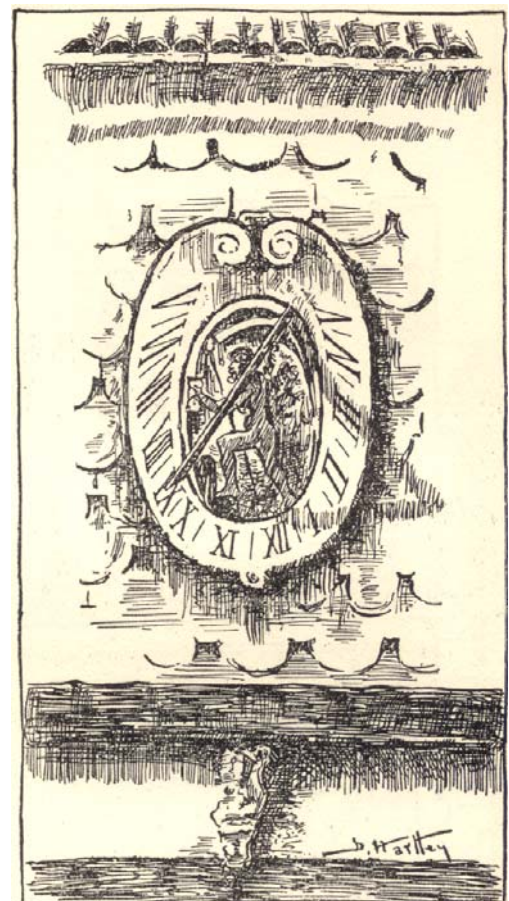
Sundial on Liberton House, Midlothian, Date 1683
